Egypt is a country on the continent of Africa. Ancient Egypt means what the country was like a long time ago - before 500 AD.


The **River Nile** flows through Egypt.

solid - a substance that is firm and stable in shape.


liquid - a substance that flows freely, but remains the same volume.
