## Geography : Rivers

**bank:** the sides of a river channel. A river channel has two banks.

**delta:** a deposit of sand or mud.

**floodplain:** low flat land along a stream that floods when the river overflows.

**meander:** a winding curve in a river.

**mouth:** the end of the river where the river meets the sea.

**source:** the beginning of a river.

**tributary:** a stream that joins a larger stream or river.



## History: Ancient Egypt

**Egypt** is a country on the continent of Africa. Ancient Egypt means what the country was like a long time ago - before 500 AD.

The **River Nile** flows through Egypt.

**ancient:** from a time long ago in the past.

**hieroglyphics:** symbols used by Ancient Egyptians to convey messages.

**mummification:** the ancient Egyptian way of preserving a body after death.



## Science - States of matter

**solid** - a substance that is firm and stable in shape.

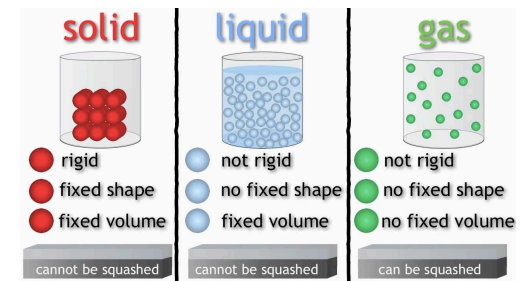
**liquid** - a substance that flows freely, but remains the same volume.

**gas** - a substance where the parts move freely and will fill any container they are in.

**evaporation** - the process of a liquid turning into a gas.

**condensation** - the process of a gas turning into a liquid.

**temperature** - how hot or cold something is. Temperature is measured in degrees ° C (Celcius)

### Drawings and Paintings

**Waterfalls:** a cascade of water falling from a height

**Floods:** overflow of water

**Waves:** a large body of water curling into an arched shape

**Rivers:** a large natural stream of water flowing.



### Mediums

**Tissue:** a type of paper.

**Papier-mâché:** a mixture of paper and glue or flour and water.

**Mod-roc:** a plaster bandage that is used for crafting.
